ACJ has been developed by winemaker Geoff Johnston to produce a seductive, alluring super-premium wine from cabernet sauvignon, shiraz and petit verdot. This wine has been crafted using different flavor profiles of each variety, and combining them into a wine which is very expressive, yet subtle and complex with a wonderful balance of flavor and tannins. The final blend was made up of wines matured for 24 months in 71% French oak and 29% American oak.
