WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2003 vintage produced grapes of excellent quality, hand-picked from the oldest vineyard on the Pirramimma Estate – dry grown bush vines planted in the spring of 1944.

The wine has an elegantly perfumed nose showing aromas of plums, cherries, violets and chocolate. These characters follow through to a complex palate that is long, rounded and flavorsome. Excellent drinking now but will reward careful cellaring for two to three years.
